Self-Audit Checklist

Use this Self-Audit Checklist if you store Hazardous substances \geq 10,000 lbs or Extremely Hazardous substances \geq 500 lbs, or \geq to their Threshold Planning Quantity, or if you have had any chemical spills to the environment.

Federal regulations include reporting requirements that provide the public with important information regarding the hazardous chemicals in their communities. This information also facilitates development of State and local emergency response plans. Hazardous Substances must be reported if they are stored in quantities $\geq 10,000$ lbs. Extremely Hazardous Substances must be reported if they are stored in quantities ≥ 500 lbs., or, \geq to their associated Threshold Planning Quantity (TPQ).

Refer to the US EPA List of Lists at http://yosemite.epa.gov/oswer/lol.nsf/homepage to determine if your chemicals are listed under Emergency Planning & Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) and Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA).

Return the completed form to the Division of Safety and Compliance (S&C), we will review your answers and provide follow-up compliance assistance as necessary.
